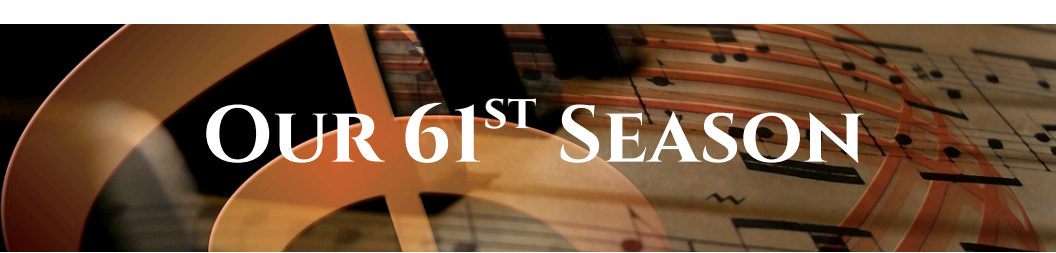

L. Brett Scott, Conductor & Music Director. Scott is Professor of Ensembles and Conducting at the UC's College-Conservatory of Music, where he conducts the CCM Chorale, teaches conducting and literature at the graduate and undergraduate level, and is Music Director of Opera d'arte, CCM's undergraduate opera company. Scott is in his 12th year as music director of Musica Sacra.

MEMORABLE MOMENTS

Musica Sacra celebrated “Sixty Sparkling Years” during our 2025-2026 season with three performances honoring our ensemble’s history while looking ahead to the future.

Thanks to the generosity of current and former members of our chorus, Musica Sacra commissioned a new work for the first time in our history, *Receiving*, by award-winning composer Jessica French, which we premiered at our Fall Concert in October 2025.

Our season continued with a special performance in February 2026 to honor the 60th anniversary of our debut concert in February 1966.

The season concludes with our Spring Concert in April 2026, where, for the first time, Musica Sacra will independently perform a full symphony.
